Dear Members of Holy Rosary Parish,

Greetings to you in Christ Jesus. It is with great admiration that I address this letter to each of you who make up Holy Rosary Parish. I thank you for your commitment to live the Gospel of Jesus, and for your willingness to serve your brothers and sisters as generously as you have for many years.

With next summer's retirement of Father Peter O'Rourke, the Pastor in your nearby parish of Holy Name of Jesus, a new chapter unfolds for the life of the Catholic community of the greater Hazleton area. This letter comes to explain a necessary change in serving the pastoral leadership needs of your community for the near future.

For several years now, Pastors and church leaders across the Diocese have been studying and discussing the range of options provided by the Church in order to meet the current challenge of a diminishing number of priests. The goal of this dialogue is always to support and sustain vibrant parishes like yours.

It is in this context that prayerful consideration has been given to all of the possible pastoral leadership responses for Holy Name of Jesus Parish, in search of the resolution that can best affirm the unique identity of each Hazleton area parish, as well as to provide the best collaboration and stewardship of resources.

In consultation with all of the Pastors of the greater Hazleton area, the decision has been made to link the two parishes of Holy Rosary and Holy Name of Jesus. Linked parishes remain fully distinct parishes, while sharing a Pastor and working toward meaningful partnership of ministries.

At the time of Father O'Rourke's retirement, I will appoint Father Brian J. W. Clarke as Pastor for both parishes. This leadership model is in place effectively in many parishes of the Diocese. A small working team with representatives from both parishes will be assembled to assist with the planning needed to make a smooth transition.

Thank you, in advance, for your understanding and support of both Pastors and of the members of each parish community as you work together to embrace this change. Be assured of my continued prayer and blessing.


